GSG MEETING

- GSG Events Board annual funding allowance increased to \$10,000 (up from \$8,500 this past year)
- approved proposal to put two young graduate alumni on the board of trustees, at least one of whom is a PhD alum. They will serve two year terms, elected annually. One to be elected one year, and the other the next year
 - this is not yet a done deal the only thing approved is a proposal by the GSG
- o approved two new housing proposals
 - 1)Introduce 2 year pilot program allowing for students with a spouse or domestic partner to live in shared 2, 3, or 4 bedroom apartments with single students. A 2 bedroom can house one couple and one single roommate. A 3 bedroom can house one couple and two single roommates. A 4 bedroom can house up to two couples and two single roommates. The couple will occupy one bedroom. Rent and utilities will still be charged per bedroom
 - 2) if you go in absentia, you retain your previous housing priority upon returning
